## COMMUNITY

A town academy with a residential program, Lincoln Academy serves 509 students from 18 towns in midcoast Maine and 37 boarding students from around the world. The academy was founded in 1801 to serve local students, whose tuition is still paid by sending towns.

The school opened a boarding program in 2015 to both increase diversity and build a reliable source of income in the face of Maine's shrinking student population.

The academy is located 50 miles northeast of Portland, with an area population of about 6000 people. The community is comprised of an eclectic mix of artists, fishermen, farmers, carpenters, professionals, laborers, and retirees.

## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

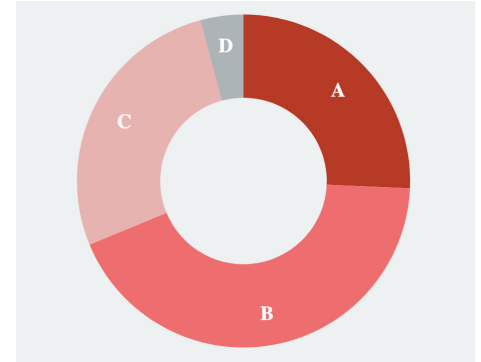
Successful completion of 22 credits: Students are required to enroll in a minimum of 6 credits per year. If students enroll in 3 or more AP courses, they may take 5 credits.

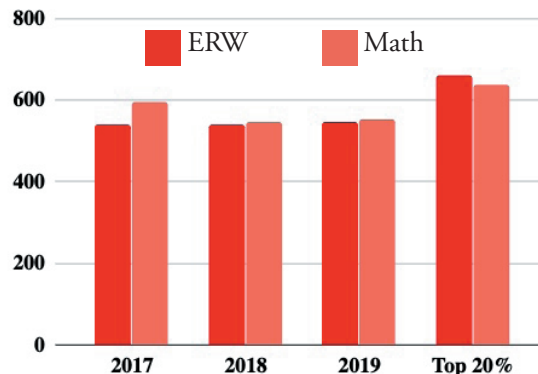


## AP EXAM RESULTS MAY, 2019
